A Word From Our Board Chair



I would like to start by thanking everyone who has supported “BMS” and has helped to make its first three years such a huge success. Without all of you this would not have been possible.

When Buddy and I walked out of the West Carteret High School Auditorium in May of 2017 after attending the scholarship awards ceremony I had no idea what was to come. The birth of an idea to give back to the community by helping the students who may not be in the top of their class but wanted to go on to some form of higher education was conceived.

I tossed the idea out to Buddy and he simply said “I think you should do it Dad”. The idea stayed with me until the week after his death in May of 2021. I knew then, that we had to do this to honor Buddy and to honor how much he enjoyed helping others. That week as family and friends came to pay their respects and show support for our loss, I pitched the idea to them. It was overwhelming just how much support was given to the idea.

Through their support and the support of many donors and participants in our fundraising efforts we have been able to award \$110,000.00 in scholarships to 24 deserving graduating seniors. Buddy would be proud of our efforts!

Thanks again and I look forward to seeing everyone during our upcoming fundraising season.
